

Northwest Minnesota Household Hazardous Waste Information

Everyone has Household Hazardous Waste (HHW). HHW is unused or leftover household products that contain hazardous chemicals. HHW must not be placed in the garbage, poured down the drain, burned or taken to a landfill. Improper disposal can pose a threat to the environment and to human health. HHW can be disposed of properly by taking it to a HHW facility or to a one-day collection event in your community. Disposal of waste at a facility or collection event is FREE of charge for residents of participating counties.

Paint Strippers	Pesticides
Adhesives and Glues	Wood Preservatives
Acids and Bases	Automotive Products
Pool Chemicals	Aerosol Cans
Fiberglass Resin	Oven Cleaners
Roofing Cement	Flammable Products

Used Motor Oil
Oil Filters
Auto Batteries

Empty containers can be placed in the trash or recycled. Check with your local recycling center.

The regional facility at Bagley is open year around for your convenience.

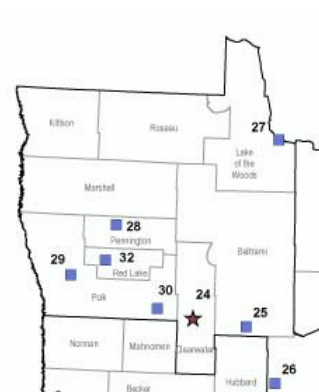
Hours of Operation:
