

SECOND ADDITION TO BAGLEY MINN

Know all men by these Presents, that the White $\frac{1}{4}$ Street Townsite Company, a corporation, owner and proprietor of all the lands herein after described, has and hereby does, by these presents, dedicate to the Public, and for the public use forever, all Streets, Avenues and Alleys as shown on the adjoining plat of the Second Addition to Bagley, Minnesota, which said "Second Addition" consists of that part of the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter [N. 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ of N. W. $\frac{1}{4}$] of Section Twenty Nine [29] in Township One Hundred and Forty seven [147] North of Range Thirty Seven [37] West, in Clearwater County, State of Minnesota, which is bounded by a line described as follows, to-wit: Commencing at the Southeast corner of said Northeast Quarter of said Northwest Quarter and running thence North, on the North $\frac{1}{4}$ South Quarter Line of said Section a distance of 787.21 feet, -thence running West 1151 Feet to the west side or line of Main Street in the First Addition to Bagley produced north, thence running South along the line of the west side or line of Main Street in the First Addition to Bagley, produced north - a distance of 786.22 feet to the north boundary line of said First Addition to Bagley, -thence running east on the north Boundary Line of said First Addition to Bagley a distance of 1151.45 feet to the point of beginning; and that said White $\frac{1}{4}$ Street Townsite Company has caused said "Second Addition" to be surveyed and laid out as shown on said Plat.

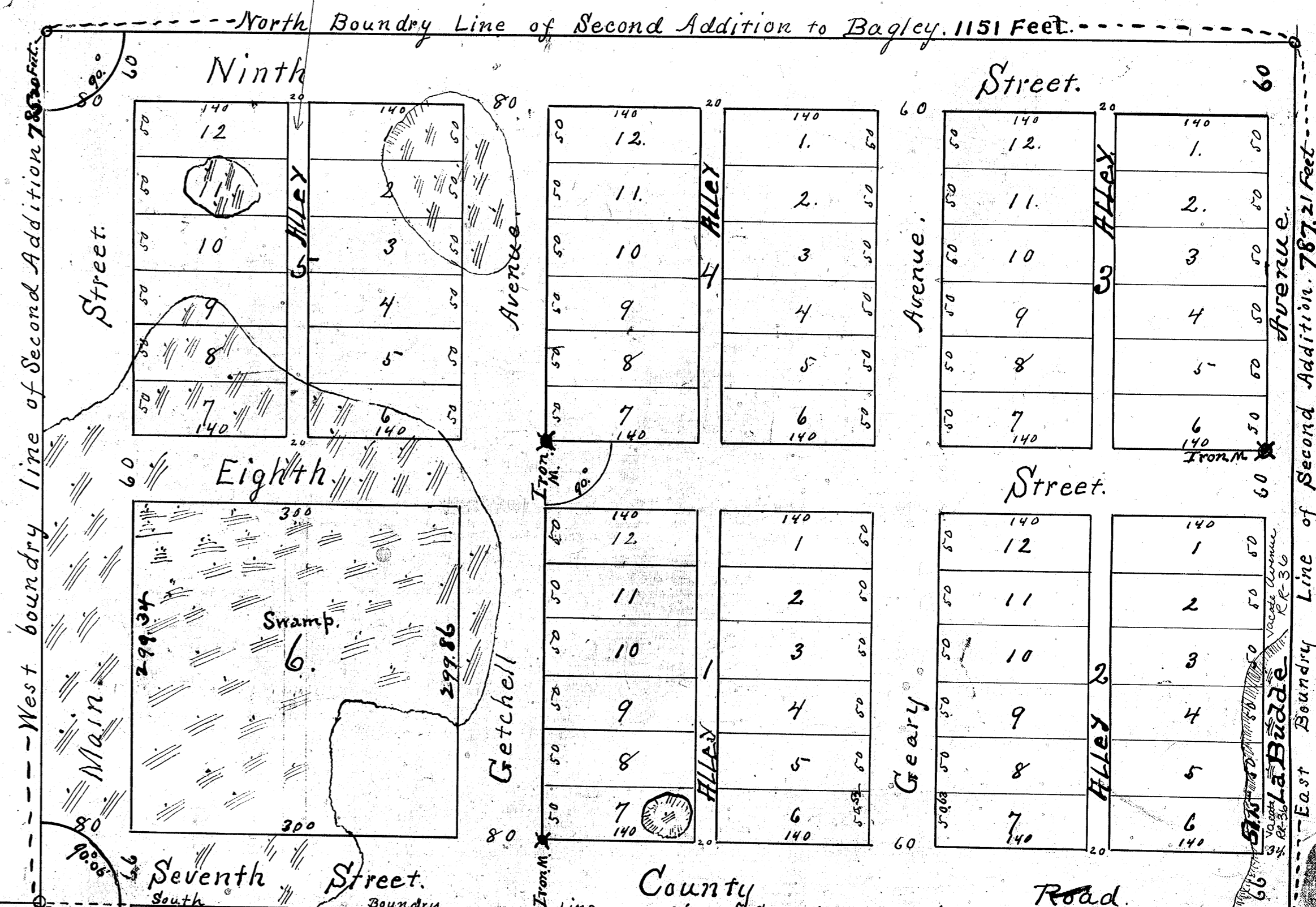
