

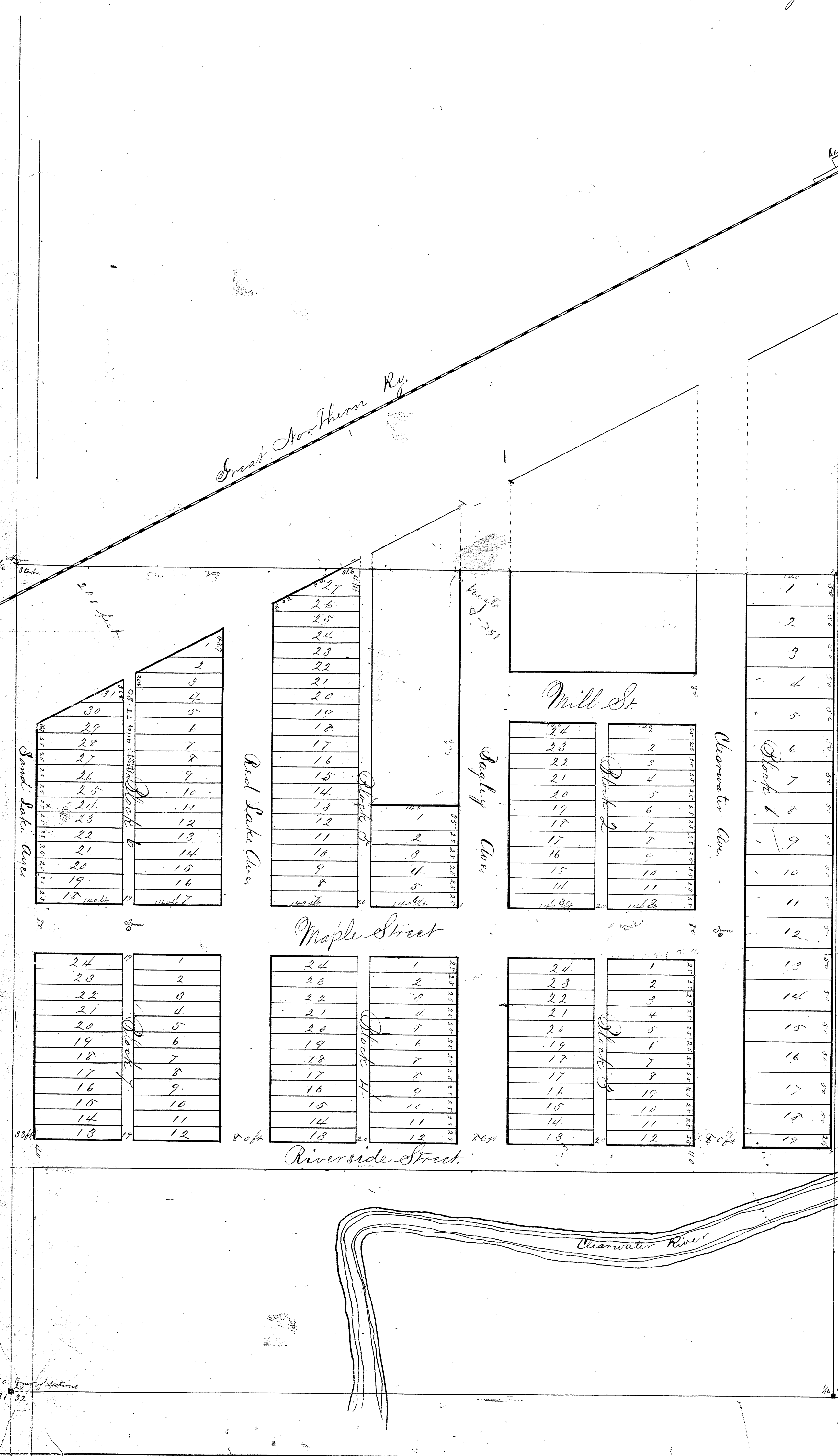
PLAT OF GROVEN'S ADDITION TO VILLAGE OF BAGLEY
