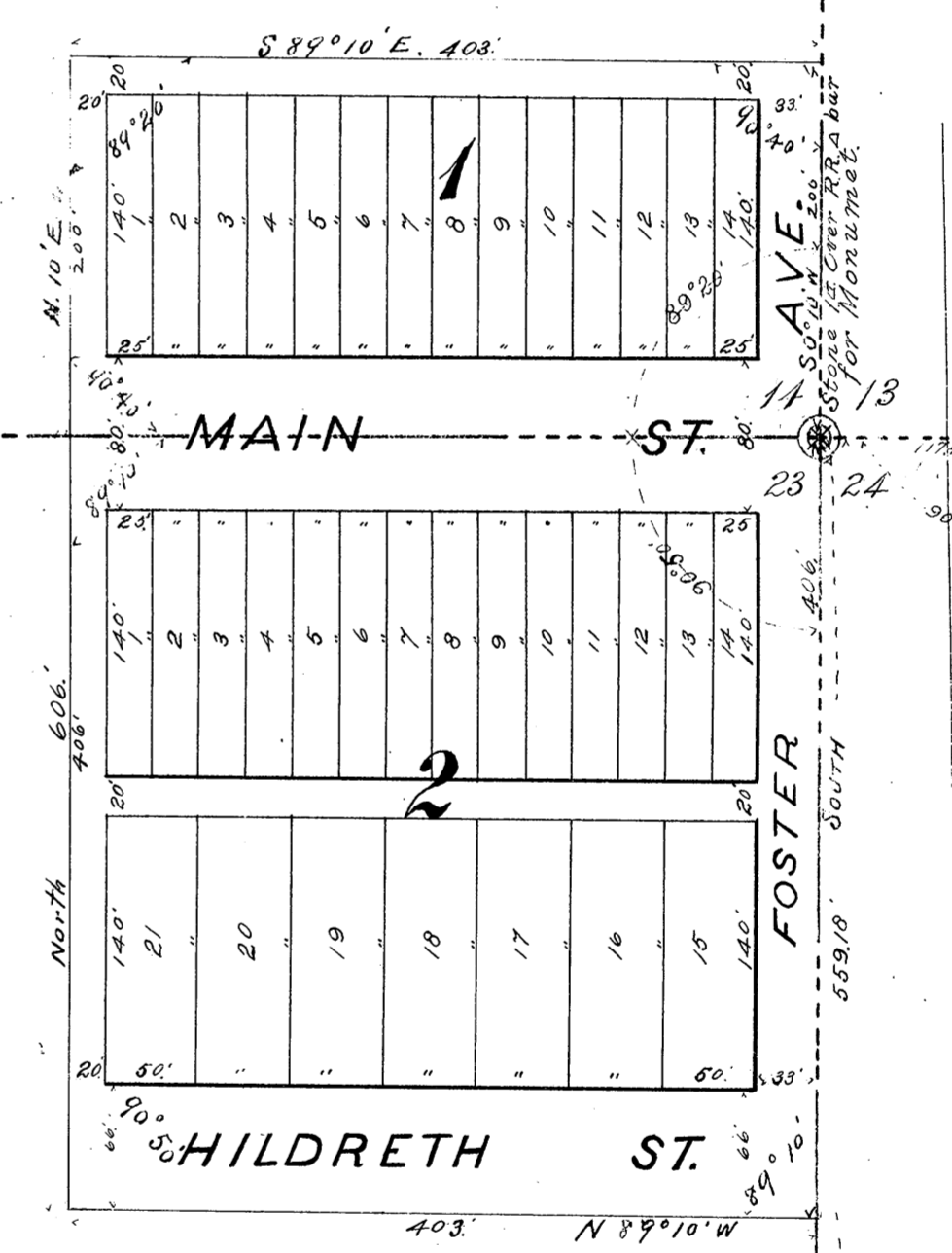

Description - The tract of land designated by the plat contained on this page and to be known as "Regina" is situated in the SE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of section 14 and the NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of section 23 in Township 146 N., Range 36 W. and more fully described as follows to wit:
Beginning at a stone monument placed at the corner to sections 13, 14, 23 & 24 in said town and range thence South along the section line between said secs. 23 & 24 a distance of four hundred six and 1/10 (406) feet to a point; thence N. 89° 10' W. a distance of four hundred three (403) feet to a point; thence North a distance of four hundred six (406) feet to the intersection with the sec. line between said secs. 14 & 23; thence N. 0° 10' E. a distance of two hundred (200) feet to a point; thence S 89° 10' E. a distance of four hundred three (403) feet to the intersection with the section line between said secs. 13 & 14; thence S. 0° 10' W. along said last described section line a distance of two hundred (200) feet to the place of beginning containing 5.94 acres which are subdivided into blocks, lots, streets, avenues and alleys as shown on plat. The blocks are numbered in large black figures, the lots in small black figures and the dimensions of all lots, streets, avenues and alleys are as shown on plat in small black figures. A stone monument with a RR angle bar driven underneath was placed at the above described section corner for the guidance of future surveys. The magnetic variation used in the foregoing courses was 9° 34'.
